## Manning takes veteran Scott's seat at RLC Board of Trustees meeting Tuesday

Larry Manning was seated as a new member of the Rend Lake College Board of Trustees, Tuesday evening, at its regularly scheduled May meeting.

Manning, 57, of Belle Rive, owns and operates a 3,000-acre family farm with his brother and son, Paul and Steven Manning. Larry Manning has farmed all his life.

He was elected in April to the RLC Board. He has been on the Tri-County Electric Cooperative Board for 15 years and served more than 16 years on the Bluford Grade School Board. He said one reason he chose to run for the RLC Board is that his service in Bluford was coming to an end and it was time for a change.

"I think being on the Rend Lake College Board is some-

thing new and exciting for me so I thought I'd try it," said Manning. "I want to thank all of those who supported me in the election."

Manning is dedicated to local youth and their education beyond high school.

"I didn't go to college," he said. "I didn't think I had the time. I don't want any more young people making the mistake I did. I think the more education the better."

Manning's ties to RLC span generations. His wife Debra, son Steven and daughter Mary, are all RLC alumni. Debra graduated in 1980 with an Associate in Applied Science from the nursing program. Steven graduated with a per-

## Fear not Freshmen!

### Upperclassmen share

Out with the old and in with the new as many people say. In the case of college campuses, this means graduates and freshmen!

A new class of excited freshmen will come to Rend Lake College in the fall. With that excitement, there may be a bit of fear or feelings of nervousness. The Clocktower Chronicle reached out to some high school students who will be freshmen at RLC next term. It also sought the advice of some current students.

"I am a bit nervous," one high school student admitted. "What if I can't find my classes? ... At my high school, we have one building and two hallways."

This is a common cause of worry. A sophomore business major at RLC said that although the campus does have more of a university layout — there are six buildings where most of the classes are held and an additional eight — it didn't take him anytime to learn where his classes were and how to get there.

"There are maps around campus if you don't want to ask," he said. "And everyone of the employees I've met are very nice and totally willing to help."

Building layouts can also be found on a smartphone, using Google Maps.

Some incoming freshmen expressed concerns about the difficulty of classes, rapport with teachers, and even going to college with older students.

One current RLC student said, "This is a place of study, and for future students to worry about their experience there is very common. But they shouldn't worry about the older students because we are all here for the same reason — to further our education."

And of course there is always the common worry over whether the classes will be difficult and if the teachers are helpful. Another current student mentioned, "A classes' difficulty all depends upon the student's level of understanding, how much they care about the subject, and also the teacher. The teacher plays a big role in the classes because of how he or she decides to present the information — either through slide shows, lecture, and homework. In my opinion, I feel that the best instructor uses all of the teaching methods, and as well seems to find a way to connect with the students in order to understand what they feel about the class."

Freshmen orientation — it's called Warrior Days — will take place from 9 a.m. to noon on Aug. 2, 9 and 17, in the RLC Theatre. Tours of campus are included and this is a great chance to ask questions.

## Scholarship Spotlight: Merritt and Ileeta Walker Philp Scholarship

The Merritt and Ileeta Walker Philp Scholarship to Rend Lake College was established in October of 2003 by Elizabeth Moore, Mary Susan Philp, Gene Philp and James W. Philp, in memory of their parents. The scholarship is funded annually through the Philp Farm Corporation. To date, it has awarded more than

\$14,000 in scholarships to 15 RLC students. The first student to be awarded the scholarship was Lynn (Karcher) Hutchison in 2004. "But my family was a middle-class family with

On the day I found out I received the scholarship to attend Rend Lake College, I cried. I never imagined in a million years that someone who did not even know me would want to financially support my education. Because of their contribution, I now have my Bachelor's in Business, work for a local nonprofit, and I am able to help support my family. I know that I would never be where I am today if they had not paved the path for me in the

beginning. Thank you for your kindness. It will be remembered always."

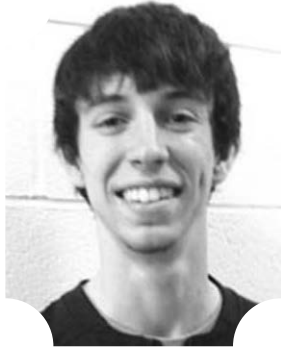
**Mallory Owens, 18, Major: Social Work A: Yes. It was a big help having dual-credit classes.**

fect 4.0 GPA from the agriculture production and management program in 2001. Steven served as RLC's Student Trustee on the Board, and he was the recipient of multiple scholarships, including the Doug Leek Memorial, Citizen's Scholarship of America, Bluford FFA, and Jefferson County Farm Bureau Foundation. Steven transferred his degree to Murray State University where he earned a master's degree. Mary — now Mary Minor — was also an outstanding student at RLC. She graduated with dual degrees in Science and Arts in 2004, transferred to Southern Illinois University in Carbondale, and now teaches at Waltonville Grade School. Manning replaces retiring Board Member Marvin Scott — a mainstay of 35 years of service to the RLC District. Scott is a Belle

Rive business owner and farmer. He has served on RLC's board longer than any member in history. Scott is among the top 10 of Illinois' longest-serving community college trustees. He represented RLC on the Illinois Community College Trustees Association Executive Board for more than a decade. "Marvin and I go way back," Manning said. "He is a very good choice," Scott said of his successor. "I think he will look out for the students. He'll be a good board member. He will do his job. I think he's a good citizen and he will have the right interests as a board member at Rend Lake College." The May 7 meeting of the RLC Board of Trustees began at 6:30 p.m. in the Student Center. Scott was in attendance for an outgoing trustee presentation scheduled at the beginning of the meeting.

### RLC's Sherrer, Roberts sign with Ole Miss track & field

Two sophomore runners with Rend Lake College's track and field team signed national letters of intent to Ole Miss before stepping foot on the national stage as sophomores. In February, mid-distance runner Holland Sherrer (Bridgetown, N.J./Cumberland Regional HS) and sprint hurdler Fred Roberts (Maple Heights, Ohio/Orange HS) met with RLC

Head Coach Jason Craig and former coaches Eric Alberter and Matt Jackson to make their commitment to Mississippi. "It's a great coaching staff at Ole Miss — a place where I can achieve what I need to do," said Roberts. "The campus is beautiful. It's one of the best campuses I've ever seen. I feel like the workouts and work ethic I accomplished here at Rend Lake got me ready. I

feel like I'm very ready for the next level of competition." "Ole Miss will expect a lot out of the workouts they will be given there," Craig said. "Rend Lake — the program here was amazing," Sherrer said. "I believe I got the training of a DI here at a Juco. I think it's made all the difference in preparing me for the next level." Sherrer was a three-time conference champ and state champion in the sprint medley at Cumberland Region. Roberts was the state runner-up in the 300m hurdles and 60m hurdles at Orange.

"I think [Ole Miss] signed me because of not only what they know from my past, but what they see for me in the future," said Roberts. "My goal is to be the best hurdler I can be and win DI nationals." Sherrer's top performances at RLC include a 50.32 in the outdoor 400m dash, 1:21.71 in the indoor 600m, and 1:52.35 in the indoor 800m. Roberts' top performances at RLC include a 7.39 in the indoor 55m, 7.09 in the indoor 60m, 24.41 in the indoor 200m, 7.38 in the indoor 55m hurdle, 7.96 in the

indoor 60m hurdles, and 14.28 in the outdoor 110m hurdles. Sherrer anchored the Warriors' national championship indoor 4x800m relay team in March. "They have a new head coach [at Ole Miss] and are looking to turn the program

around ... and win an SCC championship," Sherrer said. "I would love to be an All-American and All-conference. But the biggest goal is to do my part to help them win an SCC championship and get to nationals." Sherrer is the son of Barron and Cynthia Sherrer. "They have been there since day one, since I started running," he said. "I'd like to give a shout

out to my mom, Victoria Johnson," Roberts added. "She helped me greatly on this trail. Without her, I think I would have died a long time ago." "They are great athletes," said Craig. "They do everything I tell them and sometimes they go above and beyond." He said his advice to them is to stay focused, keep family first and look to excel in every aspect.
