WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any high school student who is enrolled in the 9th-11th grade at Benton, Hamilton County, Zeigler-Royalton or Mt. Vernon high school.

Students qualify for enrollment by:

- Demonstrating the academic potential and desire to complete a college degree.
- Exhibiting enthusiasm toward learning.
- Being a first generation college student (neither parent having a bachelor degree)
- Meeting guidelines established by the U.S Department of Education.
- Being willing to commit to weekly tutoring, monthly Saturday activities, and a 6 week Summer program.

WHAT CAN UPWARD BOUND DO FOR ME?

The *Academic Year* component emphasizes academic achievement and goal setting. It includes:

- Tutoring sessions at the student's target high school.
- Saturday College held once a month at Rend Lake College's campus which include sessions on career planning, study skills, wellness, test prep, etc.
- Field trips to educational and cultural destinations which include college visits, museums, and theatrical performances.

The Summer Program is the most intensive aspect of the UB year. This includes:

- Five weeks of classes at RLC campus in Math, English, Foreign Language, Science and an elective.
- The opportunity and tuition for up to two RLC full credit classes.
- Paid UB Career Internships for eligible students.
- End of the year trip to major cities which include campus tours, cultural activities and sites, historical tours, etc.

All activities are provided at <u>NO COST</u> to the student!
