Re: Scholarship Grants

Western Egyptian EOC, through funding from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO), has scholarships available for high school graduates desiring to further their educational training at an Illinois college or university, community college, or vocational school. Four (4) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each will be offered. Applicants must reside in Monroe, Perry or Randolph County. The scholarship will be applied toward tuition and fees; textbooks and supplies; or room and board.

Interested applicants should thoroughly read the enclosed informational sheet, follow all required application procedures, and submit the application no later than Friday, March 28, 2025 to one of our county outreach offices listed on the enclosed information sheet. Please note that an acceptance letter from the educational or training institution, or your current schedule if enrolled in college, is required in order to be considered. Additional applications are available at the county outreach offices or at the agency's central office in Steeleville where applicants may also direct their questions regarding the scholarship and the application procedure.

Additional information may be required of applicants meeting the basic criteria.

Applications will be reviewed and candidates may be requested to participate in local personal interview/discussions. Award recipients will be selected by the Western Egyptian EOC board of directors and notified by mail no later than Tuesday, May 27, 2025.

We appreciate the opportunity to offer this scholarship program to the tri-county area and would appreciate your cooperation in encouraging potentially qualified individuals to apply.

WEEOC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM "Information Sheet"

General Information

Western Egyptian EOC, through funding from the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO), has scholarships available for high school graduates desiring to further their educational training at an Illinois college or university, community college, or vocational school. Four (4) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 will be offered. Applicants must reside in Monroe. Perry or Randolph County. The scholarship will be applied toward tuition and fees; textbooks and supplies; or room and board, and will be paid directly to the school of the student's designation.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must demonstrate evidence of the following eligibility criteria:

- 1. Resident of Monroe, Perry or Randolph County.
- 2. Member of an income eligible household according to the following income guidelines. (proof required)

2025 Income Guidelines for Community Services Block Grant (CSBG) (currently at 200% until further notice)

Is my household income within 200% of federal poverty level? If your household's combined income for the 30 days prior to application (gross income for all household members, before taxes are deducted) is at or below 200% of the federal poverty level as shown in the chart below, you may be eligible to receive assistance.

- 3. Possess a high school diploma or GED from an accredited institution evidences by most recent transcript. *(transcript required)*
- 4. Be accepted at an Illinois college or university, community college, or vocational school at least on a half-time basis. (an acceptance letter from the training institution or current schedule if enrolled in college, is required to be considered)
